The teacher involvement is fantastic and you can tell that they truly love their job and all of the children. You can always tell when a person is genuinely happy doing what they do and that is definitely the case for both teachers, Nicole and Sandy (Sandy is also the owner/Director).

They are always willing and happy to discuss any concerns the parents may have (either in private or casually if appropriate) or to share with you the wonderful accomplishments or behaviors that they saw in your child that day. They both certainly find the good in each child every day. Even if there is something concerning they want to bring to your attention (which doesn't happen often since its a great group of kids!), the teachers handle it in the most professional, private, fair, supportive way and they are always open to feedback (positive or negative) from the parents and they genuinely appreciate parental involvement. The teachers are both parents themselves, so they understand how difficult a job it can be and they truly treat the parents and children with the utmost respect.
